

Reasonable Adjustment & Special Considerations Policy

Introduction

This policy is primarily aimed at learners who are registered on or have taken a course with Xtreme Emergency Training (XET). It is also for use by our staff to ensure they deal with all reasonable adjustment and special consideration requests in a consistent manner and in accordance with the relevant awarding organisation requirements.

Each awarding organisation will have specific guidelines to follow when applying for reasonable adjustments for individual learners and what can be automatically approved by centres.

Reasonable adjustments

The aim of a reasonable adjustment is to reduce the negative impact of a disability (as defined by the Equalities Act 2010) on a Learners ability to achieve a qualification. The objective is that a Learner with a disability experiences no substantial disadvantage to a Learner that does not.

Special Consideration

A special consideration is a change to an assessment outcome, mark or grade made when the Learner experiences temporary injury, illness, health or well-being problem at the time of the assessment. Learners will be eligible for special consideration if they have completed the training and covered the whole course but performance in the assessment / coursework is materially affected by adverse circumstances beyond their control.

Responsibility

XET will ensure the following:

- Every Learner is given the opportunity to achieve the qualification / unit without changing the assessment criteria or achievements.
- Identification of Learners who require reasonable adjustments prior to delivery of course.
- Where identification of a Learner who requires reasonable adjustments, XET will apply to the relevant awarding organisation for approval if required. See individual guidance provided by different awarding organisations.
- Where reasonable adjustment is approved, make necessary provision, however ensuring that assessment demand is not lowered.
- Inform Internal Quality Assurer of Learners on a qualification that is completing the assessment using a
 particular reasonable adjustment method.
- Maintain accurate records of Learners with reasonable adjustments as this will be monitored through the External Quality Assurance system.
- Supply information to the relevant awarding organisation on the use of reasonable adjustments with Learners as requested.

Review Arrangements

We will review the policy annually as part of our self-evaluation arrangements and revise it as and when necessary in response to customer and Learner feedback, changes in our practices, actions from the regulatory authorities or external agencies or changes in legislation.
